

## BEREAVEMENT WRAP TRPQG - 2017

*“One of our hospitals stated that these wraps are perfect for the tiniest preemies, under 20 weeks. They dress the babies, if at all possible, and then place them inside wraps like this one. Doing this helps the family connect with their baby by presenting the baby as 'normally' as possible.”*

*Note: The top of the square can be folded back in a 'cuff-like' style (as shown), making the wrap adaptable to different size babies .*

### **MATERIALS NEEDED:**

\*2, 12” squares of soft fabric (*flannel, fleece, velveteen, satin, etc.*)  
2, 12” Lengths of Ribbon for ties, trim as desired  
Trim (Optional)

*\*fabric squares can vary from 12”-15”, depending on desired size of finished wrap*

### **DIRECTIONS:**

1. Place the two fabric squares WRONG-sides-together (WST), & sew a 1/2" seam all the way around the edges. (*Overcast / Blanket Stitch 2.5L / 5.0W*).
2. Apply optional trim if desired.
3. Fold square into thirds & mark where the fold lies on LEFT (folded) side. Make sure bottom edges line up neatly, then top stitch as close as you can to bottom edge.
4. Measure approximately half way up from the bottom edge. Apply ribbon ties to the RIGHT-sides of both Wrap front & fold.
